# Researching a Topic

## Trust Week 2

To research submarines several skills must be developed:

- Define subject - *sub • marine* (*sub*=under and *marine*=water) under water boat
- Find in encyclopedia
- Locate library books - teach children to use computer to find library books.
- Search Google or other internet sources.
- Gather and compile information



# Researching a Topic (cont'd 2)

## Trust Week 2

### Research Books:

- Index in back
- Table of contents in front
- Picture and diagrams
- Text
- Not necessary to read entire book

# Researching a Topic (cont'd 3)

## Trust Week 2

### Using many resources:

- Mark book pages with post-it notes.
- Highlight pertinent parts of internet materials with highlighter pens.
- Make notes on post-it notes placed in book. Never write in a library book, a borrowed book, or an encyclopedia.

# Researching a Topic (cont'd 4)

## Trust Week 2

### Sifting for the best information:

- Not all information is interesting.
- Train to look for "WOW! Information" OR "I didn't know that!" information.

### Categorize submarine subtopics:

- History of submarines
- Parts
- How a submarine works
- Life on board a submarine (optional)
