Lax Units vs Intense Units

- Every unit does not have to involve people outside your family.
- Some activities can be done in snatches rather than productions.

“Tweaking” Units

Stewardship Week 5

- Most people want to be **TOLD** what to do, because complete freedom is frightening, frustrating, and calls for decisions.

But....

- If people are told what to do, then they **BALK**. “I do not want to do **THAT!**” They realize they really did want *some freedom*.

Solution...
